

Pedagogical contract

This contract establishes the commitments made between Inflexyon and students enrolled in French as a Foreign Language (FLE) training. It is signed by both parties in order to certify that the information concerning the general course of the training is known and taken into account by the student(s).

Section 1

The objectives and training programs are made available to the student on the institution's website, on documents distributed at the start of course and in folders available in the foyer* which can be consulted freely. They are based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) guidance. In addition, a description of the content for each level (from A1 to C1) is available in the appendices to this contract.

Section 2

The student agrees to ensure, on their behalf, the smooth running of the language course and therefore to:

- be present for classes and notify the school in case of any absence
- actively participate in their programme by getting involved during lessons and doing the homework
- be on time

The institution agrees to:

- provide personalized educational support at the student's request via the tutoring sessions or, in the case of a more specific request, private lessons (at an additional cost)
- provide the student with information about their programme and the resources in order to improve.
- ensure regular monitoring of the student's educational progress
- allow the student to enroll, if necessary, in a procedure to validate their acquired knowledge and advise them in this process at their request.

Section 3

The student is informed that the course sessions at Inflexyon are organized in sessions each lasting 4 weeks and correspond to 75 hours of lessons in the intensive course, 57 hours in the standard course, 45 hours in the semi-intensive course and 36 hours in the au pair course. The number of hours needed to complete a level varies from 70 to 300 hours (see appendix), this means that:

- in most cases, the student will have to redo a session in a level to work on the essential aspects more thoroughly. But this does not in any way mean that the student is repeating a level or being held back, since they will not repeat the same activities.
- whether a student moves to the next level is decided upon by all of the teachers during the pedagogical team meeting which is held at the end of each session and is based on the four skills described by the CEFR. The student has a right to question their placement in a level group, but the decision is to be made by the teachers.

From A2 to B1	300 hours
From B1 to B2	200 hours
From B2 to C1	200 hours
From C1 to C2	200 hours
